STEWARDSHIP

"I'm anxious." "By what authority can I visit?!" "...but I hate talking about money..."

Last Sunday's launch of our Stewardship Renewal month unleashed on congregation the prospect of 'a visit' from a fellow member of the church to talk about stewardship and giving. Our aim (narowly expressed) is to ensure that before the 3rd November everyone who considers St Paul's to be 'their church' will have had the opportunity to re-appraise their level of financial support for St Paul's and its activities; we have a budget to define for 2014 and we have commitments for the current year – and we all need to step up to the challenge of bearing the cost of running a 21st century church.

Our aim, more broadly stated, is that each of us will stop and think about our response to the wonder of God's gift of life, our freedom and opportunity - and about how we signal our gratitude to God for that in our 'giving back' to him in and through the church. It is all about thankfulness and gratitude: which begins with a consideration of the fact that God has put us here with our span of life with a purpose – and the life of the church is the visible expression of his presence and his love in this community. Shall we express our gratitude to God for his gifts by trimming activities, doing less, cutting back, compromising on standards? Or will our presence in Wilton Place, through our generosity, speak boldly of God's generosity in creation and in the heart of this part of London?

Every person who visits will already have renewed their level of pledged giving for the coming year (as I already had when I invited visitors to visit). That is the authority by which we invite you to do the same.


