



19 January 2014: Second Sunday of Epiphany

WE ARE SENT

I wonder if everyone is aware that the clergy say Morning Prayer Monday to Saturday at 9AM, and on the odd occasion we are happily joined by others. This, along with the daily Mass (Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays at 6PM; Wednesdays at 6.45PM and Saturdays at 12.00 Noon) provides the structure and rhythm of our daily life here at St. Paul's, not just for those present, but also, vicariously, for the lives of all who associate themselves with this parish church, as we in turn link to the Universal Church in prayer and worship.

During Epiphanytide Morning Prayer ends with these words: *"May Christ,* who sends us to the nations, give us the power of His Spirit"

That very succinctly reminds all the baptized of our call to evangelization which is very much at the heart of our Baptismal Covenant

and the theme of the season of Epiphany, which word itself means "showing forth" or "manifestation". Christ the light of the world is made manifest in our time and space in the life and worship of the church and through the hands and feet, voices and ears and touch of God's people, the Baptised, that is you and me as we go about our daily living and work. I wonder if Anglicans, and perhaps especially "Anglo Catholics", are shy about being bearers of the Good News in Jesus Christ whom we worship with such beauty and passion day by day and week by week? The "sent ones" of the Sent One. Yet the 'Post Christian culture' in which we now live cries out for a clear articulation of the Christian Faith. The "Why" and "How" of this call to be "sent" will be the focus of our workshop on Saturday 1 February 9.30 AM- 2.30 PM. We shall be using material from the Awareness Foundation, founded by Bishop Michael Marshall and the Reverend Nadim Nassar here in London. Here is one way we can respond to that daily prayer to be sent



and one way to be renewed in the essential gift of the Spirit that leads and prods! Please do join us and please sign up on the sheet at the back of the church and become an active part in the ongoing and
