


9 February 2014:

The Archbishop of Canterbury's Lent Book 2014, Looking Through The Cross, is now available on the church bookstand and in all good bookshops, and though Lent is still a few weeks away, why not shop early to avoid disappointment. Its author is The Revd Dr Graham Tomlin, the much-respected and spiritually vital Principal of St Paul's Theological Centre and Dean of St Melitus College here in the Diocese of London. He is a first-rate communicator and theologian. Its theme: the way the Cross of Jesus Christ alters and transforms our view of the world. Everything



looks different in this world through the lens of the Cross. This book deals with reconciliation, humility, identity, power, suffering, life and atonement, familar themes for a Lent book but in Graham's hands given exciting new meaning which will touch the hearts and minds of readers seeking to make sense of Christian faith in a turbulent modern world. £7.50 from the parish bookstand.


