Flights:

On the **Monday**, Easyjet flights are available from LGW (dep. 08:10) or Luton (dep. 11:45). There is an early BA flight from LHR at 06:40 – or if you're keen to travel BA but at a more reasonable time, you might consider adding an extra night, flying out on the Sunday afternoon BA flight ex. LHR at 15:40.

On the **Thursday**, Easyjet flights are available to LGW at 18:45 or there is a BA flight at 19:40 to LHR.

Trains:

On the **Monday** there is a DIRECT Eurostar train from London St Pancras at 07:19, arriving in Lyon at 13:00 – and you may prefer to fly back, OR you can get a TGV from Lyon to Lille Europe (e.g. the 14:00 arr. 17:06) and change onto one of the regular Eurostars from Lille Europe to London St Pancras (e.g. 17:36 arr. 18:06).

Accommodation:

As usual, we invite people to make their own arrangements for hotels, AIRBnBs or other lodgings, anywhere in the 1st or 2nd Arrondissement – or further afield, ad lib.
